



SWIM TEAM COACH (Seasonal/hourly/part-time/non-exempt)

Must be able to commit to team from August until April, approximately 10 hours per week.

Will be considered for Summer Team Opportunity.

Provide direct leadership, instruction and motivation for swim team participants. Must be willing to interact with assistants, volunteers and parents.

Responsibilities:

- Create thorough, age-appropriate workouts focusing on technique, endurance, stroke development, drills, etc.
- Lead structured practices
- Record all work-outs and track attendance
- Administrative matters relating to the team, swim meet arrangements and team performance as well as interaction with parents
- Coordinate and execute swim team competitions and meet registrations. Record times at swim meets.
- Attend all swim team events such as meets, meetings, social events, etc.
- Engage parents and cultivate relationships to create a collaborative swim team environment. Encourage volunteering and collective participation.
- Swim team social event planning, as necessary
- Maintain a clean and safe environment for swim team participants
- Work to promote the program through advertising and marketing.

- 2+ years' experience as a competitive swimmer
- 2+ years swim coaching experience preferred
- USA Swimming Coach or ASCA Level 1 and Principles of YMCA Competitive Swimming certification preferred
- Must be able to demonstrate proficiency of swim skills in accordance with YMCA standards and have a strong foundation in stroke mechanics and be able to communicate effectively with swimmers and their parents
- Enthusiastic, dynamic presence with good communication skills
- Certifications: CPR, AED, Basic First Aid certification
- At least 21 years of age.
- Physical Demands: Ability to swim, demonstrate, instruct & observe stroke techniques.
- Ability to lift and move equipment, and to lift a small to average size child.
